







Rainbow eye

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In Photoshop, open a picture of an eye 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Select the eye and copy to a new layer - Ctrl J Remove the pupil from the selection 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Turn on the colour swatches menu – Window, Colour – (F6) 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Select the brush tool – hardness 100%, size to match the colour portion of the eye Use [to decrease brush size Use] to increase brush size 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Select a colour swatch 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Click on the eye to paint a dot of colour Paint various coloured dots to fill the eye 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> From the Filter menu, elect blur – Gaussian blur Blur about 5 pixels [note If this blurs the whole eye rather than just the coloured dots, you probably did not paint the dots on a separate layer to the eye] 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Change the blending option to overlay If the 'rainbow' is too light, try duplicating (Ctrl-J) the coloured layer so you have more than one copy of the rainbow
